



Standards of Conduct at the Club

Bradworthy Gymnastics Club is committed to providing a safe, supportive, and respectful environment for all gymnasts. Parents and carers are expected to contribute positively to this atmosphere by observing the following:

- All behaviour and language within the club must reflect respect for others. Any use of offensive language, raised voices, or intimidating behaviour is unacceptable.
- If a concern or disagreement arises, it must be directed to a member of the coaching team. Matters will be managed appropriately and in private to ensure a calm and fair outcome.
- Confrontations between parents or carers are not permitted in any area associated with the club, including the building and surrounding grounds. Maintaining a positive environment for children is our priority.
- Where behaviour falls below the expected standard, the matter will be reviewed by the Head Coach and formally noted. Access to the club may be restricted for a period determined by the Board. Repeated or serious incidents may result in termination of membership.
- From time to time, gymnasts may need additional coaching support at the end of a session for safety or progression. Parents and carers are asked not to enter the training space or interrupt sessions. Any queries should be directed to a coach.
- The club operates a zero-tolerance approach to any form of abuse, victimisation or bullying towards staff, volunteers, or young leaders. Such behaviour will result in immediate removal from the club and may be escalated to external authorities where appropriate.

Use of Parent Communication Groups

Parent messaging groups are provided to share relevant information and updates. To ensure they remain constructive and respectful:

- Contributions should be appropriate, courteous, and related to club activities.
- Negative, inappropriate, or disrespectful comments about others are not acceptable.
- These platforms must not be used to raise disputes or grievances. Concerns should instead be brought directly to the Head Coach or management.
- Any issues between individuals should be resolved privately through the appropriate club channels, not via group messaging or social media.

- Failure to follow these expectations may result in temporary or permanent removal from the group, and in more serious cases, further action by the club.
 - In circumstances where club membership is withdrawn, fees already paid will not be reimbursed.
